We are very concerned about the rumour that the discussion is taking place at different places for a compromise for the formation of an all party government without a consensus within the seven-party alliance and without consulting the Maoists. If this is the case then it is very clear that this will not resolve the existing political problems, unless the Maoists are also invited to join the government from the beginning and without the declaration of the constituent assembly altogether.

We hope our leaders will act very carefully this time and not repeat the past mistakes.

We are only warning about the possible mistrust and division within the seven-party alliance and the Maoists as well as the people who have shown enormous courage this time, never before, and the sacrifices that are being made all over Nepal.
